#### Name of Fund:

Mary Lynn Wolpers Scholarship Endowment Fund

#### Purpose:

The purpose is to provide a scholarship for a Poplar Bluff Senior High School graduating senior to an approved post-secondary 4-year institution or technical school.

The amount of the scholarship will be determined by the Poplar Bluff Public School Foundation Board of Directors.

Criteria can be amended upon recommendation of the Poplar Bluff Public School Foundation Board of Directors to the Community Foundation of the Ozarks Board of Directors.

#### Eligibility:

The scholarship will be a one-time award to a Poplar Bluff Senior High School graduating senior planning to attend an approved 4-year college, university or a technical school.

#### Selection Committee:

The selection committee will be composed of members of the Poplar Bluff Public School Foundation Board of Directors.

#### Selection Calendar and Process:

The application deadline will be March 1 annually, unless otherwise determined by the Poplar Bluff Public School Foundation Board of Directors. Applications will be available at the Poplar Bluff Senior High School, at the Administration Office of the Poplar Bluff R-I School District, and on line through the Poplar Bluff Public School Foundation link on the Poplar Bluff R-I School District web site at <a href="http://www.poplarbluffschools.net/">http://www.poplarbluffschools.net/</a>.

Amending criteria and the committee review process will be determined by the Poplar Bluff Public School Foundation Board of Directors.

#### Notification:

The scholarship recipient will be notified by the Poplar Bluff Public School Foundation Board of Directors upon selection and will receive an award letter from the Community Foundation of the Ozarks that includes instructions for **activation** of the scholarship payment through the CFO website (www.cfozarks.org).

#### Distribution of Funds:

When required documentation is received, payment will be made to the recipient's college account. If the recipient withdraws from school, the unused funds will be returned to CFO for deposit in the scholarship fund.
